"BEGINNING at a point on the northeastern side of East Circle Avenue, which point is 15 feet northwest of the joint front corner of Lots 19 and 20, and running thence with East Circle Avenue, S. 52-45 E. 75 feet to an iron pin, joint front corner of Lots 20 and 21; thence with the joint line of said lots, N. 37-15 E. 156.2 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots 20 and 21; thence N. 53-22 W. 75 feet to a point in the rear line of Lot No. 19; thence with a new line through Lot No. 19, S. 37-15 W. approximately 155.3 feet to the beginning corner; being the same conveyed to me by Greenville Home Builders, Inc. by deed of even date herewith, not yet recorded."
