MODIFICATION AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, We the undersigned, John T. Houston and Helen O. Houston, hereinafter called the Mortgagors, were well and truly indebted unto the Mutual Life Insurance Company of New York in the original principal sum of Eleven Thousand Two Hundred (\$11,200.00) Dollars, with interest at the rate of four and one-half $(4\frac{1}{2}\%)$ per centum until paid; and,

Book 631, page 285, said mortgages being assigned to and now held by Mutual Life Insurance Company of New York; and,

WHEREAS, We, the undersigned Mortgagors, desire to make more definite and explicit the description of the real estate described in and subject to the aforesaid mortgages;

NOW, THEREFORE, We, the undersigned mortgagors hereby declare as follows:
