Greenville, S. C. , hereinafter called the Mortgagor, send(s) greetings:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto C. Douglas Wilson & Co.

organized and existing under the laws of South Carolina, a corporation  
called the Mortgagee, as evidenced by a certain promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which  
are incorporated herein by reference, in the principal sum of Ten Thousand Four hundred  
Dollars (\$10,400.00 ), with interest from date at the rate of four & one-half per centum  
(4½ %) per annum until paid, said principal and interest being payable at the office of  
C. Douglas Wilson & Co. in Greenville, S. C.  
or at such other place as the holder of the note may designate in writing, in monthly installments of  
Fifty-seven and eighty-two one-hundredths Dollars (\$ 57.82 ),  
commencing on the first day of September, 1955, and on the first day of each month there-  
after until the principal and interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest,  
if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable on the first day of August, 1955.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better  
securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three  
Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing  
and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained,  
sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its  
successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of Greenville,  
State of South Carolina:

All that lot of land near the city of Greenville, in Greenville  
County, state of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No.  
55 of Section 1, on plat of Belmont Heights, recorded in plat book 36  
pages 54 and 55, of the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, and  
having according to a recent survey made by R. W. Dalton, July 1955,  
the following metes and bounds, courses and distances, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the southwestern side of Cool Brook  
Drive, the front joint corner of Lots 55 and 56, and running thence with  
the joint line of said lots S. 64-26 W. 156 feet to an iron pin; thence  
N. 37-06 W. 71.9 feet to an iron pin, corner of Lot No. 54; thence with  
the line of said Lot N. 64-26 E. 170 feet to an iron pin on the south-  
western side of Cool Brook Drive; thence with the southwest side of  
said Street S. 24-34 E. 70 feet to the beginning corner.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belong-  
ing or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be  
had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and equipment now or hereafter  
attached to or used in connection with the real estate herein described.

To HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its successors and  
assigns forever.
