ings of any kind, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said Lucile Hill

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money
aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and also
in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me in hand well and truly paid at and before the
sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained,
sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

All those two certain lots of land in Greenville Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, being known as Lots Nos. 64 and 65 of a
Subdivision known as "Parker Heights" according to a plat of said
property recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat
Book P at page 43, and having the following metes and bounds according
to said plat:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the point where View Point Drive (Agenw
Road) intersects with Calhoun Avenue, and running thence along View
Point Drive (Agnew Road) and along line of Lots Nos. 64 and 65, 101.6
feet to an iron pin, corner of Lots Nos. 65 and 66; thence along joint
line of Lots Nos. 65 and 66, 168.7 feet to an iron pin on line of Lot
No. 67; thence 100 feet along line of Lots Nos. 65 and 64 to an iron pin
on Calhoun Avenue; thence 150.3 feet along said Calhoun Avenue to the
