All that piece, parcel and lot of land lying and being in Austin Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, about three miles eastward from the Town of Simpsonville, containing One Hundred Ninety-nine and 75/100 (199.75) acres, more or less, according to survey made by W. J. Riddle, Reg. Land Surveyor, in August 1947 as revised by C. O. Riddle, Reg. Land Surveyor, on October 13, 1954, and being the southern part of tract number 3 on map 3 of the A. R. Hunter estate lands with the original plat being recorded in Plat Book S, Page 21 and the revised plat recorded in Plat Book GG, Page 85. The original tract number 3 contained 304.75 acres, and there has been conveyed off therefrom 52.5 acres unto F. H. Mayfield and 52.5 acres therefrom unto Arthur R.
