in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Levis L. Gilstrap and Lloyd W. Gilstrap , their heirs and assigns forever:

All that lot of land in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Paris Mountain Township, known as a portion of lot no. 36 of Map No.1 of Sans Souci Heights made by W.J.Riddle dated March, 1950, said plat recorded in the R.M.C.Office for Greenville County in Plat Book W at Page 155, and having, according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the southern edge of a three foot sidewalk running along Mount Pleasant Avenue, at the joint front corner of lots 36 and 37, and running thence with the line of lot 37, S 13-28 W, 130 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of lots 36 and 37; thence S 79-thence with the line of lot 35, N 10-36 W, 100 feet; thence 35 feet, more or less, to an iron pin 8 feet from the front western corner of lot 35; thence N 76-40 W, 72 feet to the beginning.
