"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northeastern side of Lynhurst Drive, joint front corner of Lots 126 and 127, and running thence with the joint line of said fots, N. 29-12 E. 150 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot 128; thence with the rear line of Lot 128, S. 60-48 E. 80 feet to an iron pin on the western side of Texas Avenue; thence with Texas Avenue, S. 29-12 W. 125 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with Texas Avenue as it intersects with Lynhurst Drive, following the curvature thereof, the chord of which runs in a southwesterly direction, 35.40 feet to an iron pin on the northeastern side of Lynhurst Drive; thence with said drive, N. 60-48 W. 55 feet to the beginning corner; being a portion of the property conveyed to mortgagor corporation by George F. Townes, individually and as trustee by deed recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 517, page 25."
