All those certain lots, pieces, or parcels of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as lots Nos. 18, 19 and 20 on Plat of property of C. E. Briscoe made by C. M. Furman, Jr. Engineer, in May 1923, and which is of record in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book F at page 166, which three lots are more particularly described as follows, to-wit:
