NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I/we, the said mortgagor(s) in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me/us the said mortgagor(s) in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, the following described property, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Paris Mountain Township, on the northwest side of Long Forest Drive, being shown as Lot No. 25, containing 2.59 acres, as shown on plat of the property of Nabors and Bridges, recorded in Plat Book O at page 195, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northwest side of Long Forest Drive, at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 25 and 26, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 26, N. 58-30 W. 331 feet to an iron pin in line of property now or formerly owned by Turner; thence with the line of said property, N. 32-06 E. 425.7 feet to an iron pin at rear corner of Lot No. 24; thence with line of Lot No. 24, S. 27-03 E. 448.7 feet to an iron pin on Long Forest Drive; thence with the northwest side of Long Forest Drive, S. 47-52 W. 200 feet to the point of beginning; being the same lot of land conveyed to me by W. F. Nabors and R. L. Bridges by their deed dated September 27, 1949, recorded in the R.M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. 392, page 406."
