I, Gother Smith  
Whereas, I, the said Gother Smith

SEND GREETING:

hereinafter called the mortgagor(s)  
in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, am well and truly  
indebted to Mrs. Elizabeth B. Ricketts

hereinafter called the mortgagee(s), in the full and just sum of One Hundred Fifty and No/100 ----  
----- DOLLARS (\$150.00), to be paid

in seven monthly installments, the first six payments being in the sum of \$20.00 each and the seventh payment being in the sum of \$30.00; the first payment falling due on December 15, 1955, and one of the remaining payments falling due on the fifteenth day of each month thereafter until the entire indebtedness has been fully paid

, with interest thereon from date

at the rate of six percentum per annum, to be computed and paid

semi-annually until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if, before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor(s) promise to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorney's fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said mortgagor(s), in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said mortgagee(s) according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said mortgagor(s), in hand well and truly paid by the said mortgagee(s) at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mrs. Elizabeth B. Ricketts

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville and in the City of Greenville, being shown and designated as Lot Number Two on plat of property of John Henry Smith, as made September 26, 1949, by Pickell & Pickell, Engineers, and being described by metes and bounds as follows, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the Southwestern side of Cagle Street, as shown on said plat, at corner of Lots Two and Three and running thence South 48-10 West One Hundred feet to an iron pin on the Northern line of Lot Number One, thence North 42-57 West along the dividing line between Lots One and Two, Twenty-eight and 5/10 feet to an iron pin on the Northeastern line of a certain Nine foot alley, shown on said plat as a party drive; thence along the line of said alley North 48-10 East One Hundred feet to Cagle Street; thence along the line of Cagle Street South 42-57 East Twenty-Eight and 5/10 feet to the place of beginning; said lot of land being a part of Lot Six of Block "B" of the Cagle-Mauldin Subdivision as shown on plat recorded in the R. M. C. Office in Plat Book "E" at page 242.
