sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said
The South Carolina National Bank, as Trustee for Philip H. Gadsten, its successors and
assigns forever:

All that parcel of land situated near the Reid School House in
Chick Springs Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and
known and designated as Lots 3, 4, 7, 8 and 9 in the subdivision and Plat of
the property of J. H. Roberts Estate, made by H. L. Dunahoo, Surveyor, on
September 7-9, 1949, said plat being of record in the R. M. C. Office for
Greenville County in Plat Book "W", page 67, and having the following metes
and bounds and courses and distances, as shown by said Plat, to-wit:
