

TRACT NO. X:

BEGINNING at a stone and iron stake Joe Fritts' corner and running thence South 72 degrees 15 minutes West 138.5 foot to an iron stake, now corner to Fritts'; thence with Fritts' and Coble's old line South 84 degrees 20 minutes East 131 feet to an iron stake at branch; thence North 3 degrees 15 minutes East 50 feet to the point of the beginning and containing 3275 square foot, more or less, and being of a triangular shape.

TRACT NO. XI:

BEGINNING at a sweet Gum Stump in Smith's branch and now Coble's corner; thence with Coble's line the call in the old deed North 50 degrees East 571 feet to a stone Coble's corner; thence with Coble's line again North 415 feet to a stake in his line and a new corner to R. M. Fritts; thence South 70 degrees West 160 feet to a new corner to Fritts; thence South 44 degrees 30 minutes West 326 feet to a stake; thence South 1 degree 40 minutes West 109 feet to a sycamore tree; thence South 21 degrees 30 feet West 412 feet to a stake on Coble's line; thence with Coble and Fritts line a South East course 53 feet to the beginning, containing 4 acres, more or less.
