Cureton, Deceased, All those certain pieces, parcels, lots of tracts of land all that tractors or should be

lying, situate and being in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina. on and near West Parker Road about 3-1/2 miles from Greenville County Courthouse and having the following metes and bounds:
