TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

Allen D. Howland and Kathleen H. Howland (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of Fourteen Thousand Two Hundred and No/100 - - - -

DOLLARS (\$14,200.00), with interest thereon from date at the rate of five (5%) per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the southern side of Fernwood Lane in the City of Greenville, being lots 21, 22, 23, 24 and 25 as shown on plat of Cleveland Forest, made by Dalton & Neves in May 1940, recorded in Plat Book M at Pages 56 and 57, and also two lots lying immediately south of lots 21 and 22, as shown on said plat and described together as follows:

"BEGINNING at a stake on the southern side of Fernwood Lane at corner of Lot 20 and running thence with line of said lot and continuing S. 25-16 E. 187.8 feet to a stake; thence N. 64-55 E. 100.8 feet to a stake; thence N. 17-30 W. 53.5 feet to a stake; thence N. 64-44 E. 191.8 feet to a stake at corner of Lot 26; thence with line of said lot N. 25-16 E. 41.8 feet to a stake on Fernwood Lane; thence with the southern side of Fernwood Lane S. 70-00 W. 180.8 feet to a stake; thence continuing with said lane N. 82-46 W. 142.2 feet to the beginning corner."

Being the same premises conveyed to the mortgagors by deeds recorded in Deed Book 457 at Page 516, and Deed Book 457 at Page 542.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
