All that piece, parcel or lot of land with the building and improvements thereon, in the City of Greenville, Greenville County, South Carolina, on the North west side of Augusta Court and known and designated as all of Lot No. 27 and the adjoining half of Lot No. 28 of Block "B" as shown on a plat of Augusta Court, prepared by R.
