ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina on the Western side of Circle Street (formerly Brookside Avenue) in the City of Greenville, and being a portion of Lots Nos. 1 and 2 as shown on plat of Hillside Heights made by R.
