in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to us in hand well and truly paid at and before the
sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained,
sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Bank of
Piedmont, its successors and assigns forever;

All that piece, parcel or lot of land with the improvements thereon, situate, lying
and being in the Piedmont Manufacturing Village in or near the Town of Piedmont,
Greenville County, South Carolina, and being more particularly described as Lot No.
4, Section 4, as shown on a plat entitled "Property of Piedmont Mfg. Co., Green-
ville County" made by Dalton & Neves, February, 1950; Sections 3 and 4 of said
plat are recorded in the R. M. C. Office of Greenville County in Plat Book Y, at
pages 2-5, inclusive, and pages 6-9, inclusive, respectively. According to
said plat, the within described lot is also known as No. 8 Pine Bluff Street (Avenue)
