TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN: We, W. D. Rodgers, Jr. and Henrietta Rodgers

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Austin Township, located in the North East corner of intersection of Jones' Mill road and County Road, East of Simpsonville, S. C. and being more fully described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point in the center of the Jones' Mill road at western edge of County Road, and running thence along west side of County road N. 10-30 E. 208.7 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 77-30 W. 208.7 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 10-30 W. 208.7 feet to a point in the center of Jones' Mill road; thence along center of said road S. 77-30 E. 208.7 feet to the beginning corner, and being a portion of the same land conveyed to Cassie Lee Mayfield by Waymond P. Wood by deed dated October 4, 1951 and recorded in Vol. 443, page 80 in the Greenville County R. M. C. Office.

The above lot contains one acre, more or less.
