(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FOUNTAIN INN FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF Fountain Inn, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by

reference, in the sum of ~~Seven Thousand Four Hundred and no/100~~

DOLLARS (\$ ~~7400.00~~), with interest thereon from date at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be paid as therein stated, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose, and

WHEREAS, the unpaid balance of said debt or debts, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does hereby grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Fairview Township, Town of Fountain Inn, known as lot no. 3 on plat of L. F. Armstrong made by Lewis C. Godsey dated September 23, 1954 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the southwestern side of Nash Street, at the joint front corner of lots 2 and 3; thence with said street, N 53-45 W, 125 feet to an iron pin, corner of lot 4; thence with it S 36-26 W, 477.2 feet to an iron pin on line of land of Ruby Parks; thence with said land, S 73-50 E, 140.8 feet to an iron pin; thence N 22-23 E, 13.6 feet to an iron pin; thence S 79-33 E, 47.4 feet to an iron pin; on the northern edge of a 15 foot drive; thence with lot 2, N 29-41 E, 397.8 feet to an iron pin on Nash Street, the point of beginning.

This being the same property as conveyed to the mortgagor by deed of L. F. Armstrong dated September 28, 1955 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 536 at Page 82.
