(\$ 8.200.00) Dollars, or for future advances which may be made hereunder, from time to time, up to and including the maximum amount named herein, such advances to be repaid so as to be completed within the terms of the original contract, and so long as the monthly payments set out in the note are paid according to contract, this loan shall not be deemed delinquent by reason of said advances, with interest at the rate specified in said note,

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I/we, the said mortgagor(s) in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me/us the said mortgagor(s) in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, the following described property, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, within the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, known and designated as the eastern portion of Lot 89 and all of Lot No. 90 of Plat No. 2 of the property of Overbrook Land Company and Woodville Investment Company made by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book H, at page 258 and being more particularly described as follows:

"BEGINNING at a point on the southwest side of Lowndes Hill Road, the center of the northeastern boundary of Lot No. 89, and running thence along a straight line in a southwesterly direction to a point, the center of the southwestern boundary of said lot; thence S. 75-54 E. 79 feet, more or less, to an iron pin; thence N. 35-36 E. 161.5 feet, more or less, to an iron pin on the southwest side of said road; thence N. 30-30 W. 60 feet to a point, the front corner of Lots Nos. 89 and 90; thence N. 28-40 W. 30 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning; being the same conveyed to me by J. H. Mauldin by deed of even date herewith, not yet recorded."

The last payment on this mortgage, if not sooner paid, will become due and payable 20 years after date.
