Fifty-Eight and 43/100 - - - - - - - - - - - - - - - (\$ 58.43) Dollars upon the first day of each and every calendar month hereafter in advance, until the full principal sum, with interest has been paid, said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall, at the option of the holder, become immediately due and payable, and the holder may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for ten (10%) per centum attorney's fee beside all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I/we, the said mortgagor(s) in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me/us the said mortgagor(s) in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, the following described property, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, O'Neal Township, on the southern side of State Highway No. S-139, and having, according to a plat of the property of Troy J. Bridwell prepared by Terry T. Dill, L. S., March 21, 1956, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at a point in the center of said State Highway, which point is 150 feet along the center of said highway from the joint corner of the mortgagor herein and Terry T. Dill, said point also being witnessed by an iron pin on the southern edge of said highway, and running thence along other property of the mortgagor herein, S. 28-30 W. 850 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing along the line of other property belonging to the mortgagor, S. 76-00 E. 200 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing along the line of the property belonging to the mortgagor, N. 28-30 E. 850 feet to a point in the center of said state highway; thence along the center of said state highway, N. 76-00 W. 200 feet to the beginning corner; being a portion of the property conveyed to me by Terry T. Dill by deed dated June 23, 1955 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 528, at page 381."

The last payment on this mortgage, if not sooner paid, will become due and payable 18 years after date.
