NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That the said Mortgagor , in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Mortgagee according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to the said Mortgagor paid by the said Mortgagee at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mortgagee,

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the Town of Greer, lying on the South side of Hubert Street, having a frontage thereon of 78.2 feet and a rear width of 79 feet, all corners being marked by iron pins, bounded by lands now or formerly owned by Edna G. Mayfield, G.P. Garrett, Franklin Mills--now Victory Textiles Inc.-- and By Hubert Street and being all of that lot conveyed to the late Della Wilson (Brannon) by E.A. Westmoreland, as shown by record of deed in the M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 35, at page 105. This is the same property conveyed to us by Edna G. Mayfield by deed dated August 12, 1950 and recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Book 416 page 287. According to a survey and plat made by H.S. Brockman, Surveyor, dated May 2, 1956, said lot has the following courses and distances:

BEGINNING on an iron pin on the south side of Hubert Street, corner with the Mayfield lot, and runs thence with the margin of said street N. 69.33 W. 78.2 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 14.45 W. 149.5 feet to an iron pin in or near ditch; thence S. 56.05 E. 79 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 15.46 E. 167.8 feet to the beginning corner.
