"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Greenville Township, on the southeast side of Garren Drive, and being known and designated as Lot No. 205 of a Subdivision known as Oak-Crest as shown on plat made by C. C. Jones and Associates, Engineers, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for GreenvilleCounty in Plat Book GG, at Pages 130 and 131, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southeast side of Garren Drive at the corner of Lot No. 204, and running thence along the line of that lot, S. 72-25 E. 176.7 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of said lot in the line of Lot No. 199; thence along the rear line of Lot No. 199, S. 11-55 W. 78 feet to an iron pin in the rear corner of Lot No. 206; thence along the line of that lot, N. 86-04 W. 183.9 feet to an iron pin at the corner of said lot at the east side of Garren Drive; thence along the line of said Garren Drive following the curvature thereof, N. 15-40 E. 93.1 feet to the beginning corner; being the same conveyed to me by Brown, Inc. by deed dated May 17, 1956, not yet recorded."
