EXTENSION AGREEMENT

THIS AGREMENT made this day of may, 1956, between the Fidelity Federal Savings & Loan Association, of Greenville, South Carolina, a corporation, chartered under the laws of the United States, hereinafter called "FIDELITY", and Charles L. Hudson, hereinafter called "OBLIGOR"

## WITHESSETH THAT:

WHEREAS Fidelity is the owner and holder of a note dated
June 18th, 1953, executed by Charles L. Hudson and delivered to Fidelity
in the original principal amount of \$8,900.00, and secured by a mortgage
upon said premises shown as lot #9, on a plat of Ed B. Smith, prepared
by C. C. Jones October 1951, said premises being located on Perrin
Street, said mortgage being recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville
County in Book of Mortgages 565 at Page 509, title to which mortgaged
premises is now vested in said Charles L. Hudson subject to said note
and mortgage which are hereinafter called the Obligation and said
Obligor has requested Fidelity to extend the time for performance of
the obligation; NOW THEREFORE,

L. Fidelity agrees to extend the time for payment of the principal indebtedness of \$8,214.58 now remaining unpaid under the obligation so that it shall be payable as follows: \$53.94 on the 1st day of August, 1956, and a like payment of \$53.94 upon the first day of each month thereafter until paid in full, and if not sooner paid, the balance on the 1st day of Becomber, 1973, said payments to be applied first to interest at the rate of four per cent, the balance to principal.
