per centum per annum
until paid; interest to be computed and paid annually and if unpaid when due to
bear interest at same rate as principal until paid, and I have further promised and agreed to pay ten per
cent of the whole amount due for attorney's fee, if said note be collected by attorney or through legal
proceedings of any kind, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said Florence Holliday

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money
aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and
also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me in hand well and truly paid at and before
the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted,
bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Robert
L. Brownlee, his heirs and assigns:

All those two tracts of land in Gantt Township, containing
26.7 and 5.28 acres, more or less and more particularly described
as follows:

TRACT 1: All that tract of land containing 26.7 acres
more or less, BEGINNING at a pin and running thence S. 71 W. 20.71
chs. to a stone on J. R. Henderson line; thence S. 20 3/8 E. 7.20 chs.
to a post on the Fork Shoals Road; thence S. 38 1/2 E. 3.79 chs.
to a stone; thence S. 73-25 E. 5.24 chs. to a pin in a road; thence
N. 62 1/2 E. 10.50 chs. to pin in the Conesstee Road; thence N. 69 1/2 E.
2.09 chs. to a bend in the road; thence S. 85 3/4 E. 1.58 to a Oak; thence
N. 57 3/4 E. 2-50 chs. to a stake; thence N. 26 1/4 W. 12-50 to the
beginning corner.

TRACT 2: All that tract containing 5.28 acres and BEGINNING
at a pin in the Old Fork Shoals Road, near the present road and
running thence S. 88-07 E. 13.84 chs. to a W.O.; thence N. 36 E.
2.63 chs. to a stone at a persimmon; thence N. 36 W. 4.60 to a stone
at a R.O. thence N. 80 3/4 E. 1.58 to a bend in the road; thence
S. 69 1/2 W. 2.09 chs. to bend in road; thence S. 62 1/2 W. 10.50 chs.
