All that piece parcel or lot of land in Oaklawn Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing 82 Acres, more or less, (Less 15-1/2 Acres previously sold to Duke Power Company), being designated as Tract No. 1 as shown on a plat recorded in Plat Book G at page 290 in the Register of Mense Conveyance Office for Greenville County and having the following metes and bounds to wit;
