NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee pursuant to the covenants herein and also in consideration of the further sum of Three (\$3.00) Dollars to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, his heirs, successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the Western side of Merlocke Avenue, in the City of Greenville, being a portion of lots #19 and 20, on a plat of property of Rachel J. Cely, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book Mat Page 45, and according to a survey made by C. C. Jones on February 1, 1956, is described as follows:

"BEGINNING at a stake on the Western side of Merlocke Avenue, at the corner of lot #11, and running thence with line of lots #11 and 12, S. 54-03 W. 161 feet to a stake; thence S. 36-04 W. 58.2 feet to a stake; thence N. 54-03 E. 154.3 feet to a stake on Merlocke Avenue; thence with the Western side of said Avenue, N. 28-35 W. 58.2 feet to the beginning corner."
