Presents, am well and truly indebted to Vernon Duncan

in the full and just sum of Five hundred thirty and no/100 (\$530.00) dollars -

- , to be paid in monthly instalments of twenty-five dollars each month from date for first eleven months from date, and entire balance due twelve months from date hereof,

, with interest thereon from June 30th, 1957,

at the rate of 6 per centum per annum, to be computed and paid annually from June 30th,

1957, in advance,

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear

interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Vernon Duncan, his heirs and assigns:-

That certain tract or parcel of land, with the improvements thereon, in School District 13-F, and Highland Township, said County and State, containing twenty acres, more or less, and being the remainder of the tract conveyed to me by deed of T W Moon, Sept.25th, 1926, after deducting about four and a fraction of acres therefrom in various deeds, and now this tract having the following courses and distances, after deducting therefrom the said 4 and fraction acres heretofore sold, to-wit:-

Beginning at a stake at the intersection of the road leading out from house on the said lands conveyed herein into the Greenville Road; thence along said Greenville Road to the line between T. W. Moon and Thomas Lindsey; thence along said line S 66.
