SEND GREETING:

Whereas, **I**, the said **Frank H. Dean**
in and by **my** certain **premissery** note in writing, of even date with these
Presents, **am** well and truly indebted to **The Pelzer-Williamston Bank**

at the rate of **6** per centum per annum, to be computed and paid **semi-annually**

interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying, and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Dunklin Township, School District 10E, near Daventon Church on the waters of Horse Creek, and being known as a portion of the Allisen Tract of the James Scott Estate, and having, according to a survey made on Sept. 4, 1942, by W. M. Nash, Engr., the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
