All that piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being near the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, South Carolina, designated as Lot No. 10 of Sevier Court on plat prepared for Leslie & Shaw, Inc. by C. C. Jones & Associates, dated February 29, 1956, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book EE at page 180, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Eastern side of Bahan Street, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 9 and 10, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 9, S. 88-10 E. 121.2 feet to an iron pin in the line of Lot No. 8; thence with the line of Lot No. 8 S. 1-50 W. 60 feet to an iron pin in the line of property now or formerly of Osborne; thence with the line of property now or formerly of Osborne N. 88-10 W. 118.5 feet to an iron pin on the Eastern side of Bahan Street; thence with the Eastern side of Bahan Street N. 0-42 W. 60 feet to the point of beginning.
