BEGINNING at a stake on the southeastern line of North Street (extended), said place of beginning being the corner common to Lots 15 and 16, and running thence S. 44-21 E. along the dividing line between said Lots 15 and 16, 192.8 feet to a stake; thence N. 39-42 E. 91 feet to a stake at the corner of Lot No. 17; thence N. 41-29 W. along the dividing line between Lots 16 and 17, 184.8 feet to a stake on the southeastern line of North Street (extended); thence along the southeastern line of North Street (extended), S. 48-3 W. 50 feet to a stake; thence continuing along the southeastern line of North Street (extended), S. 41-28 W. 50 feet to the place of beginning; being the same conveyed to me by Mrs. Sarah J. Wysor by deed dated April 23, 1948 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 346, at page 211."
