MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

SEND GREETINGS

WHEREAS, I/we the aforesaid mortgagor(s) in and by my/our certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents am/are well and truly indebted to FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS & LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREEN-

VILLE, in the full and just sum of Six Thousand, Four Hundred and No/100 - - - - -

(\$6,400.00) Dollars, or for future advances which may be made hereunder, from time to time, up to and including the maximum amount named herein, such advances to be repaid so as to be completed within the terms of the original contract, and so long as the monthly payments set out in the note are paid according to contract, this loan shall not be deemed delinquent by reason of said advances, with interest at the rate specified in said note,

(the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference) to be repaid in installments of

be due and payable **Eighteen (18)** years after date. The note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall, at the option of the holder, become immediately due and payable, and the holder may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for ten (10%) per centum attorney's fee beside all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I/we, the said mortgagor(s) in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me/us the said mortgagor(s) in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, the following described property, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville in Greenville Township, being known and designated as Lot No. 190 of a subdivision known as Oakcrest, Section II, according to a plat thereof prepared by C. C. Jones & Associates, Engineers, January 1955 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book GG, at pages 130 and 131, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the western side of Lynhurst Drive, joint front corner of Lots 189 and 190, and running thence along the joint line of said lots, S. 64-56 W. 156.6 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots 192 and 191; thence along the rear line of Lot 191, S. 16-28 E. 65 feet to an iron pin on the northern side of Florida Avenue; thence along the northern side of Florida Avenue, N. 67-54 E. 140 feet to an iron pin; thence following the curvature of Florida Avenue as it intersects with Lynhurst Drive, the chord of which is N. 22-45 E. 35.4 feet to an iron pin on the western side of Lynhurst Drive; thence along the western side of Lynhurst Drive, N. 23-59 W. 50 feet to the beginning corner; being a portion of the property conveyed to mortgagor corporation by George F. Townes, individually and as trustee by deed recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. 517, at page 25."
