To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

I, Barbara Jean Bishop, SEND GREETING:  
Whereas, I, the said Barbara Jean Bishop  
in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these  
Presents, am well and truly indebted to G. R. Fowler  
in the full and just sum of Three hundred fifty (\$350.00) & no/100---Dollars  
, to be paid \$5.00 weekly from date, until the full amount  
of \$350.00 is paid,

, with interest thereon from date  
at the rate of 6 per centum per annum, to be computed and paid annually  
until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear

interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, that I, the said Barbara Jean Bishop  
, in consideration of the said debt and  
sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said G.R. Fowler  
according to the terms of the said note, and also in  
consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said Barbara Jean Bishop  
, in hand well and truly paid by the said G. R. Fowler  
at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said  
G. R. Fowler, his heirs and assigns forever,

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in the State and County aforesaid, being known and designated as Lot No. 105 on a plat of Brookwood, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book BB, at Page 27, and having, according to said plat, the following courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northern side of Gantt Drive at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 104 and 105, and running thence with the joint line of said lots N. 3-15 E. 193.3 feet; thence N. 87-30 W. 100 feet to an iron pin; thence with the joint line of Lots Nos. 105 and 106, S. 3-15 W. 193.8 feet to an iron pin on the Northern side of Gantt Drive; thence with Gantt Drive S. 87-30 E. 2.7 feet and S. 87-45 E. 97.3 feet to the beginning corner.
