TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

I, **William H. O'Shields**

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto **John S. Rogers**

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the sum of **One Thousand Twenty-Five and No/100**

DOLLARS (\$ 1025.00),

with interest thereon from date at the rate of **Six** per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid: **\$50.00 on principal on October 17, 1956, and a like payment of \$50.00 on principal for the next 19 successive months, and \$25.00 to be paid on the 21st month after date, with interest thereon from maturity at the rate of six per cent per annum, to be computed and paid monthly**

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee pursuant to the covenants herein and also in consideration of the further sum of Three (\$3.00) Dollars to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, his heirs, successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on **Randall Terrace, in the City of Greenville, being the Southern portion of lots # 88 and 89, as shown on plat of Woodside Circle, made by C. M. Furman on March 25, 1920, recorded in Flat Book E at Page 219, and described as follows:**

BEGINNING at a stake on the Southern corner of lots 89 and 90, and running thence with the line of said lots, in a Northeasterly direction 30 feet to a stake; thence N. 66-00 W. 50 feet to a stake in line of lot 87; thence in a southwesterly direction 30 feet to a stake; thence S. 78-51 E. 50 feet to the beginning corner.

Being the same premises conveyed to the mortgagor by the mortgagee by deed to be recorded.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
