ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, lying and being on the Northeasterly side of East Welborn Street, near the City of Greenville, S. C., being shown as Lot No. 48 on the plat of Anderson Street Highlands as recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book "J", page 157, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
