All of that parcel or tract of land situate and being in Butler Township of Greenville County, South Carolina, in old Pliney School District, on waters of Enorse River and near the Bennett's Bridge lying on both sides of a road that leads from the Bennett Bridge Road to the Old Woodruff Road, bounded by lands of Esau Hudson, the pld T.T. Thompson place, Thackston and possibly others, and having the following courses and distances:
