Flora B. Styles, her heirs and assigns: All my right, title, interest and estate in and to all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville County, South Carolina on the eastern side of U. S. Highway No. 25, located about three-quarters of a mile above Travelers Rest and according to plat prepared by Terry T. Dill, Surveyor, November, 1955, having the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at a point on the eastern side of U. S. Highway No. 25, corner of Montgomery Land and running thence S. 31-32 W. 175 feet; thence S. 37-37 W. 170 feet; thence S. 45-19 W. 270 feet; thence S. 51-08 W. 418 feet to the Race Path Road; thence along Race Path Road N. 76-38 E. 1519.3 feet to a point on Montgomery Land; thence along Montgomery land N. 63-28 W. 849.4 feet to the beginning point.
