All those three lots of land, less a small strip sold to Vance and Rosseta Jackson, situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, Chick Springs Township, in the new City limits of the City of Greer, S.C., lying on the west side of Lanford Street, and being shown and designated as Lots Nos. 59, 60 and 61 on plat of propert known as "WESTMOREL AND CIRCLE," said plat made by W.J. Riddle, Surveyor, December, 1921, and having the following courses and distances, towit:
