from date at the rate of SEVEN ((7%) per centum per annum until paid; interest to be computed and paid annually and if unpaid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal until paid, and we have further promised and agreed to pay ten per cent of the whole amount due for attorney's fee, if said note be collected by attorney or through legal proceedings of any kind, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That we, the said Dillender B. Pittman and Flara Mae Pittman in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to us in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said E. L. Craigo, his heirs and assigns forever,

ALL that lot of land situate on the Southwest side of Pittman Circle near the City of Greenville, having the following metes and bounds according to a survey made by R. K. Campbell:

BEGINNING at an iron pinat a bend in Pittman Circle, said pin being located 275 feet Southwest from the point where the Northwest side of Pittman Circle intersects with the Southwest side of Parker Road and running thence along the Southwest side of Pittman Circle S. 27-0 E. 138 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 56-0 W. 200 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 27-0 W. 138 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 56-0 E. 200 feet to an iron pin on the Southwest side of Pittman Circle, the beginning corner. Being the same property conveyed to us by J. A. Pittman by deed recorded in Deed Book 552, at page 529, RMC Office for Greenville County.
