Lots 5 and 6 on a plat of the property of James R. Cooper, deceased,
made by B. F. Neves, Surveyor, filed in the Office of the Clerk of
Court, Greenville County, South Carolina, in Judgment Roll Book E-2881,
and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds,
to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southwestern side of Geer
Highway at its intersection with Cooper Street and running
thence along the southeastern side of Cooper Street S. 61
W. 1.96 chains to an iron pin; thence running S. 29 E. 1.02
