WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto TRAVELERS REST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF Travelers Rest, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by

reference, in the sum of Six Thousand and no/100

DOLLARS (\$ 6,000.00), with interest thereon from date at the rate of six & one-half per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be paid as therein stated, and

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does hereby grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Bates Township, on the north side of Lindsey Lake Road, and containing 1.47 acres and more particularly described according to survey and plat made by Terry T. Dill, November, 1959 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in plat book 00 at page 397, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the north side of said road; thence with other property of Broadus King, N 30-50 E, 210.5 feet to an iron pin; thence still with his line, N 60-06 W, 333.5 feet to an iron pin; thence with property of Edgar F. Epps, S 15-43 W, 217.1 feet to an iron pin on said road; thence with said road, S 60-10 E, 276.5 feet to the beginning.
