"BEGINNING at a stake on the western side of Airport Road at the corner of Lot No. 50-A; and running thence with the line of said lot N. 74-30 W. 18.0 feet to a stake; thence N. 1-13 E. 412.8 feet to a stake at corner of Lot No. 67-A; thence with the line of said lot S. 74-30 E. 115.3 feet to a stake on Airport Road; thence with the western side of said road S. 15-30 W. 400 feet to the beginning corner."
