in 36 monthly installments, \$24.50 being payable on October 1, 1960,  
and \$23.50 each and every month thereafter until the full amount is  
paid

with interest  
from maturity at the rate of seven per centum per annum  
until paid; interest to be computed and paid annually and if unpaid when due to  
bear interest at same rate as principal until paid, and we have further promised and agreed to pay ten per  
cent of the whole amount due for attorney's fee, if said note be collected by attorney or through legal  
proceedings of any kind, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That we, the said George Williams and Rosa Louise  
Williams in consideration of the said debt and sum of money  
aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and  
also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to us in hand well and truly paid at and before  
the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted,  
bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said  
Luke Forrester, his heirs and assigns:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements  
thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in  
the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Greenville Town-  
ship, known and designated as a southern portion of Lot No. 26 on  
Glenn Road as shown on a plat thereof by H. S. Brockman, Surveyor,  
August, 1943, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in  
Plat Book "M" at page 75, and being more particularly described as  
follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 26  
and 25 on the northwest side of Glenn Road, and running thence with  
the common line of said lots, N. 32-45 W., 88.13 feet to a stake in  
said line; thence N. 87-30 W., to an iron pin in the joint line of  
Lots Nos. 27 and 26; thence with the common line of said lots,  
S. 34-30 E., 101.1 feet to an iron pin on Glenn Road, joint front  
corner of Lots Nos. 27 and 26; thence with Glenn Road, N. 62-00 E.,  
100 feet to the point of beginning, and being the southern one-sixth  
portion of Lot No. 26 as shown on the plat above referred to; being  
the same conveyed to us by Clate Davis by his deed dated August 13,  
1952, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in  
Vol. 461 at Page 75.
