SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I the said J. T. Minyard

in and by my certain promissory note in writing of even date with these Presents, am well and truly indebted unto the CITIZENS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, Greer, S. C., in the full and just sum of Twenty-five Thousand and no/100 - - - - - (\$ 25,000.00) Dollars, with interest from the date hereof at the rate of per cent (%) per annum, unpaid interest to bear interest at the same rate, to be repaid in installments of

C., according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three (\$3.00) Dollars to me the said mortgagor, in hand well and truly paid by the said mortgagee, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents (receipt of which is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said CITIZENS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, Greer, S. C., its successors and assigns:

That certain lot, parcel or tract of land, with all improvements now constructed thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, City of Greer, lying on the South side of old N.S. Highway No. 29, now West Pointsett Drive, known and designated as Lots Nos. 78 and 80 on a plat of property made for the W. H. Brockman Estate, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book H, at page 32, having the following courses and distances:

Lot No. 78: Beginning on an iron pin in the southeastern intersection of West Pointsett Drive and Hunt Street, and runs thence with the eastern margin of Hunt Street S. 12.00 W. 175 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 78.00 E. 70 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of Lots Nos. 78 and 79; thence N. 12.00 E. 175 feet to an iron pin on the South side of West Pointsett Drive (Old U.S. Highway No. 29); thence along the margin of said Highway, now West Pointsett Drive, N. 78.00 W. 70 feet to the beginning corner, being all of that lot as conveyed to C. B. & Wilda S. Hollifield by Vernon Duncan, by deed recorded in Deed Book 416, at page 154.

Lot No. 80: Beginning on an iron pin, the front joint corner of Lots Nos. 80 and 81 on the south side of West Pointsett Drive, formerly old U. S. Highway No. 29, and runs thence with the common line of these lots S. 12.00 W. 175 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 78 W. 70 feet to an iron pin, corner of Lot No. 79; thence with the common line of Lots Nos. 79 and 80 N. 12.00 E. 175 feet to an iron pin on the South side of West Pointsett Drive, formerly Old U. S. Highway No. 29; thence therewith S. 78.00 E. 70 feet to the beginning corner, and being all of that lot as conveyed to C. B. & Wilda S. Hollifield, by deed dated Nov. 12, 1951, recorded in Deed Book 445, at page 471.
