MORTGAGE

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

Luther Jones:

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto South Carolina National Bank (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the sum of Four Thousand Three Hundred Sixteen and 73/100 ---

DOLLARS (\$4,316.73),

with interest thereon from date at the rate of six per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid:

\$50.00 per month, beginning March 2nd, 1961, and continuing on the 2nd day of each succeeding month thereafter, until paid in full; with interest thereon from date at the rate of six per cent, per annum, to be computed and paid monthly, until paid in full;

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns: "All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville,

in the City of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot No. 33 on Plat of property of Nicholatown Heights #2 recorded in Plat Book M, at page 5, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County; said lot fronts 40 feet on River Street and extends back 120 feet on each side.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
