KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That The Bank of Travelers Rest, South Carolina, owner and holder of a certain mortgage from Vernon Calvin Anders, dated the 18 day of November, 19 55, and duly recorded in the Office of the C.C.P. & G.S. for Greenville County, State of South Carolina in Mortgage Book 659, page 275, in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar, receipt whereof if hereby acknowledged, does hereby release and forever discharge from the lien, operation and effect of the said mortgage the following described property:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and more fully described as follows:
BEGINNING at a stake in the intersection of a dirt road and a county-maintained dirt road leading to Hunt's Bridge Road; said stake being the common corner of Anders and Watson property, and runs thence along said dirt road that divides Watson & Anders property, N 1-00 E, 280' to a stake, a new corner in old line; runs thence, a new line, S 51-00 E, 241' to a stake in margin of aforesaid county-maintained dirt road; runs thence along said road, S 46-15 W, 107.81' to a stake; runs thence still along said road, S 65-00 W, 125.2' to the point and place of beginning, being a portion of that certain tract of land conveyed to Vernon Calvin Anders by deed of J. D. Mahaffey, dated Oct. 5, 1954, and recorded in Deed Book 509, page 370, Greenville County Registry.

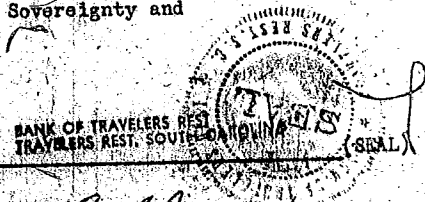
