WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto

, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of South Carolina, hereinafter called the Mortgagee, as evidenced by a certain promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the principal sum of Nine Thousand and no/100 Dollars (\$ 9,000.00), with interest from date at the rate of five & one-fourth per centum (5 1/4 %) per annum until paid, said principal and interest being payable at the office of Aiken Loan & Security Company in Florence, South Carolina, or at such other place as the holder of the note may designate in writing, in monthly installments of Forty-nine and 77/100 Dollars (\$ 49.77), commencing on the first day of May, 1962, and on the first day of each month thereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable on the first day of April, 1992

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina: near the City of Greenville, in Butler Township, on the southeast side of Greenwood Avenue, shown as Lot No. 24 on plat of Hudson Acres recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "Y", at page 39, and more particularly shown on plat of the property of Charles West and Wilma C. West prepared by R. B. Bruce dated March 10, 1962 and described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin on the southeast side of Greenwood Avenue at the front corner of Lot No. 23, which pin is 155 feet northeast of the intersection of said Avenue with Rockmont Road; running thence with the southeast side of Greenwood Avenue, N. 51 E. 175 feet to an iron pin, the front corner of Lot No. 25; thence with the line of said lot, S. 37 E. 263.7 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 40 W. 94.7 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 74-45 W. 159.1 feet to an iron pin, the rear corner of Lot No. 23; thence with the line of said lot, N. 31-30 W. 154.3 feet to the beginning.
