All that piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Bates Township, known as Lot 16 on plat of property of E. S. Bulman; recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in plat book BB at page 35, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
