TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

R. F. MELTON

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto CAROLINA FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, Greenville, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the sum of **Four Thousand Six Hundred and No/100ths-----** DOLLARS (\$ **4,600.00**), with interest thereon from date at the rate of **six and one-half--** per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be paid as therein stated, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose, and

WHEREAS, the unpaid balance of said debt or debts, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable,

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being **at the Northwestern corner of the intersection of Englewood Drive and Fairfield Road, Gantt Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lots Nos. 63 and 64 as shown on a plat of Section "A", Englewood Estates, dated October, 1951, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book Y at page 140, and having, in the aggregate, according to said plat the following metes and bounds:**

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northern side of Englewood Drive at the joint corner of Lots Nos. 63 and 65, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 65 N. 2-30 E. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 87-30 E. 198 feet to an iron pin on the Western side of Fairfield Road; thence with the Western side of Fairfield Road S. 17-02 W. 130.4 feet to an iron pin; thence with the curve of the intersection of Fairfield Road and Englewood Drive, the chord of which is S. 51-02 W., 43.3 feet to an iron pin on the Northern side of Englewood Drive; thence with the Northern side of Englewood Drive N. 87-30 W. 124.7 feet to the point of beginning.

This is the identical property conveyed to the mortgagor herein by deed of Claude L. Rankin and Lillian L. Rankin, dated April 23, 1963, and to be recorded herewith in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina.
