(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. "All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, **shown as Lot No. 1 on plat of Property of Jack Wherry & C. L. Miller recorded in Plat Book KK at Page 109 in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:**

**BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northeastern side of White Horse Road at the joint front corner of Lot Nos. 1 and 2 and running thence with joint line of said lots, N. 62-07 E. 478.8 feet to an iron pin on the southwestern edge of a service drive; thence along said drive, S. 28-38 E. 100 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 62-07 W. 475.8 feet to an iron pin on the northeastern side of White Horse Road; thence along the northeastern side of White Horse Road, N. 30-20 W. 100 feet to the beginning corner.**
